The Westborough Fine Arts Education Association (WFAEA) awards scholarships to qualified seniors attending Westborough High School.

Scholarships offered include:

Participation in the Arts Scholarship:

This scholarship is awarded to WHS seniors who have dedicated themselves to participating in courses and activities within the Fine Arts Department for all 4 years of their high school career and earned at least an A average in any fine arts classes.

Passion for the Arts Scholarship:

This scholarship is offered to WHS seniors who plan on pursuing post-secondary studies in the Fine Arts. Eligible students must have a declared Fine Arts major and have dedicated themselves to participating in courses and activities within the Fine Arts Department for all 4 years of their high school career, earning at least an A average in any fine arts classes.

Any application submitted for the Passion for the Arts Scholarship will automatically ALSO be eligible for the Participation Scholarship. All applications will be reviewed by Fine Arts Faculty and scholarships will be awarded at Graduation.

Deadline to apply is noon EST on May 2, 2023.



CENTER STAGE

This past January, WHS students involved in Center Stage put on an amazing production of the play 'The Laramie Project.' The performance left the audience in awe with its powerful message and flawless execution.

For those who are not familiar with the play, 'The Laramie Project' is a docudrama that tells the story of Matthew Shepard, a gay college student who was brutally beaten and left to die in Laramie, Wyoming, in 1998. The play portrays the aftermath of the incident and the impact it had on the town's residents.

The students' performance was a testimony to their dedication and hard work. They aptly captured the emotions and sentiments of the play, leaving the audience captivated and emotionally touched.

Summer Band Camp 2023

The Westborough Public Schools Fine Arts Department will be hosting Summer Band Camp 2023!

Summer Band Camp is offered to students entering Grades 5 and 6 as beginners in our school band program.

Where: Westborough High School

When: Summer Band Camp is a two week camp. Attendance for campers is required for all days, both weeks. The camp will run from Monday, July 10, 2022 through Friday, July 21, 2023, from 8:00am - 12:00pm.

Transportation: Families will be transporting their students to and from Westborough High School. Pick up time is at 12:00 noon, unless students will be staying for the afternoon Community Ed program.

Instrument information for beginner band students entering Grades 5 or 6:



Selecting a band instrument that is most appropriate for each individual student is a very important part of the beginning band process. This will be determined through the Band Instrument Petting Zoo at Mill Pond, which will be held on Friday, May 12, 2023 during school for all rising fifth graders, as well as rising sixth graders who did not participate in band during their fifth grade school year. The Petting Zoo is an opportunity for your student to try all of the band instruments, and will receive a recommendation based on which instrument appears to be the best fit for them.

Cost: The tuition is \$475.00 per student. Students who will be beginners will also need to obtain a band instrument. More information on this at a later date. Families who have financial questions or needs please contact Chris Martin at martinc@werstboroughk12.org.






